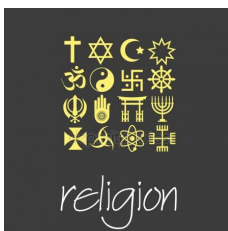

## WORLD RELIGIONS CLASS



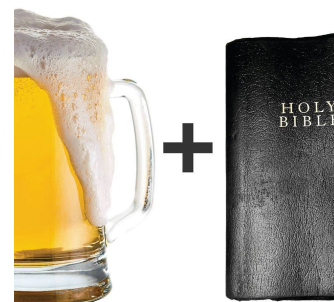
