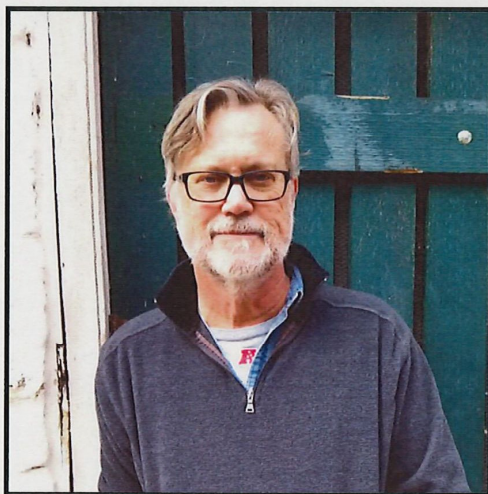
## **AUGSBURG CENTENNIAL SINGERS IN CONCERT**
