

#### **Re-Entry Committee Update**

On March 18, Church Council approved the moving to Phase II in our COVID-19 Preparedness Plan, effective April 1. After a year from our last in-person worship service, we see this as a sign of hope! This phase will allow a slight easing of restrictions. Though we are weary, we are respecting the congregational feedback and health experts to be cautious and have a gradual re-opening process.



#### What is allowed in Phase II?

- Up to 25 people will be allowed in the building (up from 10).
- For outside activities, the building can be open, provided there is a plan to ensure no more than 25 are inside and one inside bathrooms. This would allow bathrooms to be open for outdoor services.

#### What is still the same?

- Worship is by invite only and shall be primarily online. With more people allowed in the building, the Sunday leadership may expand. There may be larger and additional supplemental activities.
- Staff shall primarily work at home.
- There shall not be shared food, including communion.
- No group singing (individual singers and instruments should be 12 feet away).

#### How is the Re-Entry Committee determining when we should move between phases?

-The COVID-19 Preparedness Plan has thresholds, measured by the state health department, to determine when it is appropriate to loosen restrictions. We have been specifically monitoring the state positive case rate, using the 7-day rolling average as well as the county case rate, using the 14-day case rate. In the last month, we have also started monitoring the state vaccination rate.

#### What's next and when we will re-open?

Recommended practices and guidelines often change. Thus, the Re-Entry Committee hasn't firmly set dates or guidelines for future phases. Based on today's information, we expect five phases in total. Each phase will allow for a gradual expansion of activities. Re-Entry Committee is specifically looking for the vaccination rate to be higher before moving to the next phase (and monitoring to ensure the positivity rate does not increase).

Expenses continue to exceed giving by  $^{\sim}$  (\$6,200) per month & our YTD deficit is (\$12,484). While beginning the year with a deficit is consistent with our giving/expense pattern over the past few years, we are down (\$10,467) more than last year at this time. YTD-Year to Date Giving/Income is down (\$21,566) vs. last year while expenses are down (\$11,099).

Our PPL Loan forgiveness application was submitted to TCF this month (status is still TBD). The Memorial Fund received 1 donation this month on behalf of Thomas Parker.

To date it appears giving/income is strengthening a bit in March. We would love for this to be the start of a new trajectory for 2021! We ask that you continue to consider how you might further support the ministry here at GA.
