Lent!

Advent, Christmas, and Epiphany are behind us for another year, our annual congregation meeting has come and gone, winter is beginning to wane, and spring is almost (almost) in sight. (As I type this in late February, snow is forecast throughout the day) And a congregation's heart turns to ... Lent!

- **Shrove Tuesday, March 1, at 6:00-7:00 p.m.**, we will kick off the Lenten season with an online pancake supper together over Zoom. Shrove Tuesday, Fat Tuesday, and Mardi Gras are all names for the same celebration when we party hard and get rid of all the fat or lard in our homes in preparation for the sparse journey through Lent. Each family is invited to make your own pancakes and join us there won't be a program, just conversation and connecting with one another.
- Ash Wednesday, March 2, at 7:00 p.m., we will gather at Mt. Carmel Lutheran Church (1701 St. Anthony Blvd, NE) and online for a service of Holy Communion and Ashes. I will be preaching. This is an opportunity for us to get to know our friends at MCLC as we explore ministry partnerships together.
- Wednesday evenings, March 9 April 6, at 7:00 p.m., GA will meet at GA for a series we did not get to finish when the pandemic locked us down in 2020: Disciplines of Our Faith: Hospitality, Service, Community, Simplicity, and Justice and Peacemaking.
