#### Annual Congregational Meeting Sunday, January 29 – In the Sanctuary and on Zoom!

We will hold our annual Congregational Meeting on Sunday, January 29, after worship. Like our worship services, the meeting will be a hybrid meeting – you can attend in person in the sanctuary or via Zoom. This year's



meeting will be especially important. As you're aware, we're in the process of providing feedback on the Mission Site Profile (MSP) which we will use to help us find a new settled pastor. We will seek congregational approval on the MSP at the annual meeting. We will also hear about a potential Capital Campaign in the coming year. And as is the case every year, we'll hear reports from staff and committees, hear a presentation and approve an operating budget for 2023, and elect several church council members for 2023. A copy of the proposed 2023 budget will be available at church the week before the meeting.


Conversations will be held in the Welcome room (enter through the education doors, head up the stairs and it's the cozy little room straight ahead).



The figures above represent our income/expenses through Nov 30, 2022.

November 2022 YTD Actual Income of \$280,122.15 represents 86% of our budgeted \$316,079.52. November 2022 YTD Expenses of \$290,092.51 represent 92% of our budgeted \$316,079.49. The -\$9,970 difference constitutes our YTD deficit.

As compared to last year, YTD our income is -\$43,254.96 and our expenses are up \$9,935.42.


